Prior to COVID the church was open 5 days a week for the public visits. Since COVID it has only been open 2 1/2 days but beginning October 1, 2025 it is once again open for the public to visit from 12:30 am -3:30pm, Tuesday-Friday and Sundays. It is planned that by the new year it will be open 9:30 am-3:30 pm Tuesday-Friday and Sundays 12:30-3:30.

Memorial Presbyterian Church was completed in March 1890 after only one year of construction. It has since been an active place of worship ever since with services on Sunday at 8:30 and 11:00. The church was funded by Henry Flagler and designed by Hasting and Carrere, two American architects that also designed the Ponce de Leon Hotel which is now Flagler College. The church is a thing of beauty with it's 92 stained glass windows, 5,000 piped organ, mahogany pews and screening walls. In addition to the sanctuary the public can visit the mausoleum where Henry Flagler and some family members are entombed.

Visitors can walk around the sanctuary, take pictures, visit the two rooms where there is information about the church decorations and the Flagler Kenan family. Or they may choose to listen to some of the history about the

St. Augustine South Reflections

Well, the bad weather hasn't gone away in the last month, has it? Hurricanes Humberto and Imelda made history for close proximity, passing up the Atlantic coast

on Sunday September 28 and Tuesday September 30. The really amazing factor was Humberto "over performing" to quote a meteorologist and dragging Imelda up the coast behind it, without Imelda making landfall. That path was not certain as none of the models used for predicting the path of hurricanes had data from a prior circumstance like that.

St. Augustine South did get a lot of rain over those days, and then we had the October full moon – the Harvest Moon as it was the full moon closest to the autumn equinox - and its related king tides. Drainage ditches along Shore Drive and through the neighborhood were already full of water from the hurricanes passing us by. We had the inevitable king tide flooding. Neighbors living along Prince and Jasmine, with backyards backing onto a drainage ditch, have continued to be concerned by the high level of water in that ditch putting their homes at risk of flooding.




Flooding at Lewis Point 10/11/25 3 hours after the high tide But in true Florida fashion, we had lovely warm sunny days after the full moon followed a week later by more heavy rain. Perhaps the ground is so waterlogged with all the inundation that the ditches can't carry the water away

fast enough. The County Roads and Bridges Department had barely completed their project replacing and renewing culverts under Shore Drive when the heavy rains first started with Humberto. This work had been ongoing in St Augustine South for many weeks and involved replacing the concrete Hume pipes under the road. Between the intersections of Shore with Faun and Argos, and the intersection of Shore with Wisteria, there was fairly major engineering involved. Roads and Bridges constructed a huge earth dam to keep out the tidal water and a smaller upstream dam to hold back water in the drainage ditch. They had pumps and generators working 24/7 even over the weekend when there was no work being done, to move the water from the ditch to the creek through temporary pipes.

Shores Community Time Capsole Opened

Time Capsule from May 5, 2000 Unearthed and Displayed at The Shores Monthly HOA Meeting

At the September 11, 2025, St. Augustine Shores HOA meeting, residents had the unique opportunity to step back in time as a time capsule buried on May 5, 2000, was officially opened and its contents revealed. The event was a nostalgic and meaningful moment for the community, as it reflected 25 years of local history, growth, and change.

The contents of the capsule were carefully arranged for display, allowing attendees to observe a fascinating array of memorabilia from the turn of the millennium. Among the items preserved were:

- Local newspapers and magazines from 2000, offering a glimpse into the headlines, stories, and advertisements of the time.
- An original Sears catalog, a relic of an era just before the rise of online shopping.
- Old MLS (Multiple Listing Service) books showcasing real estate listings and property values from the period.
- A community phone book, a now-rare piece of daily life before the smartphone era.
 A commemorative scroll, signed by local residents, community leaders,
- and 5th grade students from Hartley Elementary School in 2000. This gesture symbolized the intergenerational spirit of the Shores community.

 We were honored to welcome Carol McCloud, a longtime St. Augustine Shores

resident. Carol and her husband Doug were very instrumental in organizing and sealing the original time capsule 25 years ago. Their foresight and dedication to preserving local heritage made this memorable moment possible.

A special thanks is extended to Hydro Aluminum (formerly VAW Aluminum) for generously donating the aluminum vault that safely housed the capsule's contents for a quarter of a century. Their contribution ensured the materials were preserved in excellent condition.

As we reflect on the past, this time capsule serves as a reminder of our community's journey and inspires us to think about the legacy we will leave for future generations.



Dad did experience the terrorist attack of 9/11 but he wasn't alive to see the capture of Saddam Hussein or Osama Bin Laden.

World events aside and much more importantly, mom and dad missed out on so many life events of our family. They would have gone to many football, basketball and soccer games, listened to Erik's guitar shredding (maybe not for very long) and watched the boys graduate. They would have experienced the births of their great-grandchildren. Fortunately, they missed the passing of their third son at the age of 52 and the passing of my wife's father. Mom missed the passing of her own mother. Luckily, she had just visited her the year prior - she knew it would be the last time.

Joy, sorrow and times uncertain and yet one thing's is certain; mom and dad were lucky people with an adventurous spirit. Despite a lifetime of challenges, mom and dad were perfect for one another - they loved one another, persevered in the face of adversity, challenged their children in many unconventional ways and they had many good friends who loved and respected them.

How time flies. Aren't we all lucky to be able to reflect back on all of our life experiences over the last 25 years? Maybe it's time for us to set aside a few moments, just a little bit of time, to let someone know how lucky they have made us feel?

What might our world look like 25 years from now? Keep the Faith! On that note, I wish everyone, as always, a Sunshine State of Mind.







